Spring Greetings for May!

This is one of the loveliest times of the year – the birds singing and the flowers blooming and the leaves on the trees out giving a fresh bright green.

It is also a wonderful time of year in the Church Calendar. The Easter season comes to an end with Ascension Day on Thursday 18th May. Throughout Easter weeks we recalled the stories of the risen Lord in our weekly worship. The risen Jesus showed himself many times to his followers to reveal God's great love by saving the world through his sacrificial death to enable all to come to God through him. In his risen life he then reveals God's power over evil and death. The disciples have been affirmed in their faith and now the Lord is returning to the Father in heaven, and they are commissioned to continue Jesus' ministry of love and justice in the world. It is a challenge for his followers to do so without his physical presence with them, so God sends the Spirit to come alongside them and guide them which we remember at Pentecost on 28th May.

Over two thousand years have passed, and Jesus' ministry of reconciliation is ongoing through the Church. At the Free Church we have ongoing ministries: growing in discipleship through the post Lent course; by offering hospitality through Tookey's café; the Tots and Carers Group helping parents and young children; Migrant Welcome supporting and helping local asylum seekers settle into British life; as active members on the Eco Faiths group, seeking to care for our environment; and by supporting the arts through poetry, concerts and hosting the gardeners club, photography club and seniors and bereavement groups. The Holy Spirit is alive and well and working in our world and we celebrate the Spirit's coming and working in our lives this month.

May we grow in faith and understanding and be faithful in our work and witness to God's grace and mercy and bring God glory.
